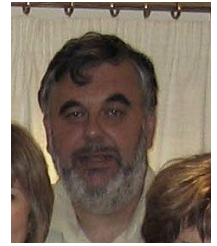


## Penpix of Directors

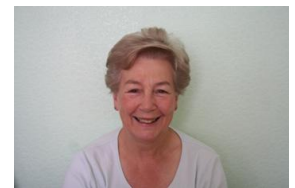
### ★ **Trevor Hollingum** - Hassocks
